1. Registration and Participation Fees

Regular fee 80 EUR, for students 60 EUR.

Includes the symposium and coffee breaks and a Reception on June 13.

Participants from Ukraine are exempted from fee, but registration with a 0 EUR price is needed.

Conference dinner on June 14 is additional 20 EUR.

2. **Destination Tartu**

The conference location is **TARTU**, the historical university town, located in South-Estonia. Tartu is also the **European Capital of Culture 2024**, with an extensive variety of activities to see and attend.

UT is ranked in the top 1.2% of the world's universities making it one of the leading universities in Northern Europe.

When booking in both locations, please use keyword "Fraunhofer".

Negotiated period of stay with indicated prices is June 12-16.

Deadline for booking May 1. First come-first served principle applies.

Tartu has direct air connection with Helsinki (HKI, Finnair) https://visittartu.com/plane

Other closest airports are Tallinn (TLL, 180 km) and Riga (RIX, 250 km). There is a regular bus connection from both airports to Tartu central bus station. Bus tickets can be bought online: T-PILET https://www.tpilet.ee/en. Choose TLL or RIX airports (departure/destination) when travelling directly from/to the airports.
